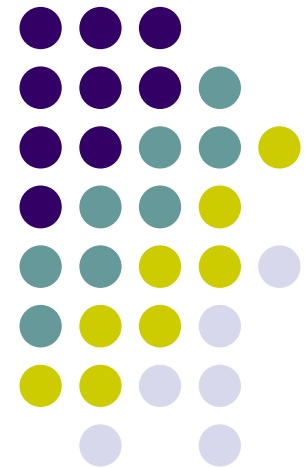

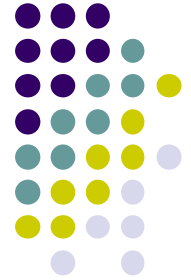
Our Job as Teachers



Is to help you to:

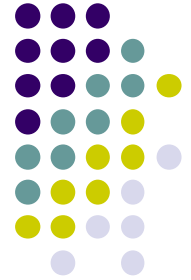
- Grow your relationship with Jesus

- Listen to directions and follow them.

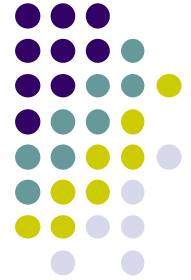
Rule #2

Attendance

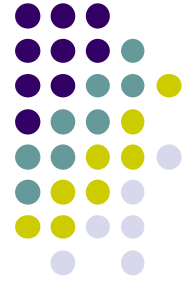


- Come to school every day.
- Plan your morning and arrive on time.
You start school at **8:30 A.M.**
- Consequences for tardies/absences.

Uniform Dress



- Come to school in the correct uniform ***every day***.
- White polo shirt that is ***tucked in at all times***.
- Navy blue shorts or pants. Girls may wear a plaid skirt/skort/jumper.
- Socks must be ***white*** and **over** the ankle.
- Shoes: Tennis shoes or other closed-toe shoes.
No boots, Uggs, or sandals.
- Thursday: Spirit-wear shirt with uniform bottom.
- NO nail polish.
- Hair must be neat and groomed.



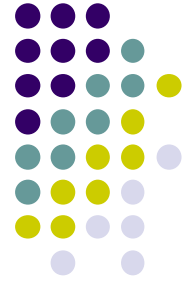
Friday Mass Dress

- Begins Friday, August 28
- White polo shirt that is ***tucked in at all times.***
- Boys: Blue pants (***no shorts***)
- Girls: Plaid skirt, skort, or jumper
- Optional: Pullover sweater, cardigan, vest
- Socks
- Shoes



Recess

- Obey the adults on duty.
- Play in correct area on playground/field.
No running around buildings, halls, or bathrooms.
- Play safely.
- Invite others to play.
- Share all equipment.
- If you brought it out, you bring it back.



Lunch

- Walk to the lunch tables.
- Appropriate behavior at lunch tables:
 - Sit while you eat
 - Chew with your mouth closed
 - Throw away your own trash
- Raise your hand to be dismissed.
- Place your lunch box on the bench.
- Only visit the office for emergencies.
