# FACTS

(GRANTS & Financial Aid Application)

## Submitting your Financial Aid Application Online Application Deadline: February 16, 2018

To apply for financial aid, please visit <http://sjmhs.org/admissionsaid/financial-aid-facts/>

Financial aid is intended to help qualified students attend Memorial who may not otherwise be able to do so because of limited financial resources. For the 2017/18 school year, Memorial awarded \$675,000 in financial aid. Financial aid is awarded in the form of tuition reduction grants. The amount of each award is based upon the demonstrated financial need of the student's family in relation to all other families applying.

The following supporting documents are required to complete the application process:

- Copy of 2016 Federal Form 1040, 1040A or 1040-EZ U.S Individual Income Tax Return. If applicant and co-applicant file separately, we require both tax returns for the 2016 tax year. We do not require state tax returns.
- Copies of all 2016 W-2 Wage and Tax Statements for both applicant and co-applicant.
- Copies of supporting tax documents if you have business income/loss from any of the following:
  - Business – Schedule C or C-EZ and Form 4562
  - Farm – Schedule F and form 4562
  - Rental Property – Schedule E (page 1)
  - S-Corporation and Partnership – Schedule E (page 2), Form 1065 (5 pages), Schedule K-1 and Form 8825
  - Estates and Trusts – Schedule E (page 2) Form 1041 and Schedule K-1
- Copies of supporting documentation for household Non-Taxable Income such as: Social Security Income, Welfare, Child Support, Food Stamps, Workers' Compensation, and TANF. If you do not file a tax return, you are required to provide documents for all income received.

After completing the online application, these documents may be uploaded to the FACTS site or faxed to 866-315-9264. All documentation is imaged upon receipt and then destroyed. You may login to FACTS to review the status of your application.
