### A Message from the Principal

As a newcomer to Fresno and St. Anthony of Padua School, I am often asked by my family members and friends whom I left behind, "What is it like at your new school?" Each one will be another SAS "family" moment as I join in the experience for the first time. I hope to see you there at each of our school events - our SAS family is not complete without you.

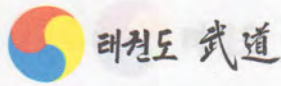
