Dear Families,

Thursday is Veteran's Day, a day set aside to honor those who have served honorably in the military. In the midst of our busy day, let's talk with our children about the people in our families and in our circle of friends who are veterans. Need a place to start? Try some of these ideas:

- *If a family member lost their life in the war, pull out a family picture album featuring their photos.* Place the album on a coffee table for the week to allow the family to look at the pictures and ask questions.
- *If you don't know the family stories yourself, ask a parent, grandparent, aunt or uncle to share with you and your kids.* Even if extended family live far away, a phone call can open the door to learning more about family members you never knew.
- *When sitting down for a family meal Thursday evening, tell your children about Veteran's Day.* Help them understand why it is important to honor those who protect and fight for our freedom.
- *Visit the grave of a family member who died in the service.* Talk to your children about who they were and what they were like. Place a small flag on the grave to show honor.
- *Display an American flag at your home.* Have your kids help you put the flag out and explain to them what our flag represents.

As parents and grandparents, you and I play an important role in helping our children understand the unique country in which we live. We have to share the stories from generation to generation. Make this Veteran's Day truly a holiday to remember.

We respect them, we thank them, we honor them, we are proud of them, and we pray that you will watch over these special people Lord and bless them with peace and happiness. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.

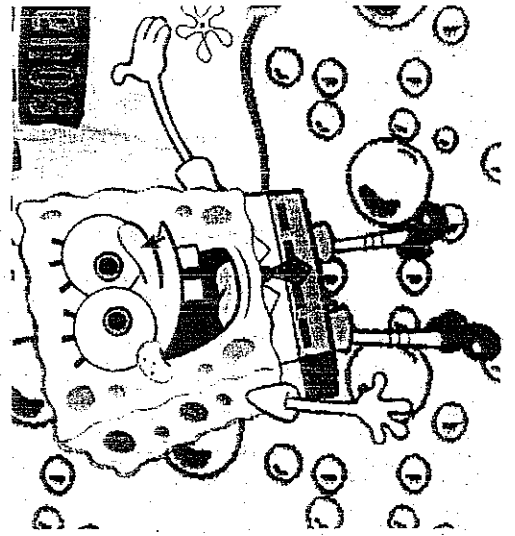

Here's what you do

1. Sign up supporters and list the amount they pledge on this form. Contact friends, relatives, parents co-workers etc.
2. Make checks payable to "St. Anthony's School"
3. On the day of the **Raider Run**, turn this completed pledge form in to your teacher.
4. After the event, collect any outstanding pledges. All pledges must be turned in to school by Wednesday after Thanksgiving in order to receive a t-shirt.
5. Each student collecting at least \$35.00 in total pledges will receive a Raider Run T-shirt. Each family collecting at least \$70.00 in total pledges will guarantee a T-shirt for each family student.
6. Participants can walk or jog for up to one hour. You can run 20 laps at a steady jog. If you run /walk 20 laps and your total pledge per lap is \$5.00 you have just made \$100.00. It is suggested that you do not take less than \$0.10 per lap or \$2.00 in flat pledge.
