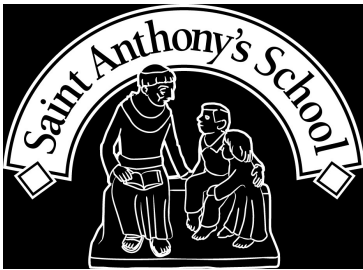

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2014-2015 TUITION RATE SCHEDULE

Dear Parents,

In order to maintain a quality education, our Advisory School Board has approved a minimal tuition increase for the 2014-2015 school year. It has always been the mission of the Administration to maintain affordable tuition. Thanks to your hard work and that of our Parent Teacher Organization fundraisers and the Scrip Program, St. Anthony's School is able to offer its families one of the lowest tuition rates in the entire Diocese of Fresno. All associated costs relating to salaries and employee benefits costs will also increase approximately 4-5% (i.e. payroll taxes, retirement, and medical and liability insurances). In addition, our annual Office of Catholic Education assessment and testing fees are being increased.

We do understand that any increase will be felt by our families. In order to offset your tuition costs we highly encourage every family to use the **Scrip Program. Many families earn months of FREE tuition each year....by simply using the SCRIP PROGRAM!** This program was designed for the sole benefit of helping our families decrease their tuition cost. Everyone has the opportunity to save at least one month of tuition by using the program at the minimum. The savings increase as your usage increases. This is an effortless and positive incentive to help offset your tuition. If you have any questions on how to better utilize this money-saving tool please ask. We are here to help with this issue. Your cooperation is essential to reducing your tuition cost.

Please realize that we are doing our absolute best and encourage anyone who is anticipating this increase to cause a financial hardship to contact me. Financial tuition assistance is available upon request.
