Greetings from Mr. Neumeier, Principal

.I think that you will agree with me that the best way to avoid misunderstandings is to have ongoing, clear lines of communication with one another. The more information we receive the more we feel we are an important part of the team. When we support one another and do our best to understand one another, we are less likely to jump to conclusions or form opinions that may not fit the situation. Soon parents and teachers will meet for conferences. Here are a few thoughts to guide your time together:

1. Arrive on the correct day and time. You will have your teacher's undivided attention, use this time well. Make sure each person knows the best way to reach one another and the particulars about when each should be contacted.
2. Allow your teacher to get back to you with information or answers that are not readily available at the conference. More thought may be needed or resources gathered to address the issue fully.
3. Communicate strategies that work at home and share them with your teacher. Come up with an action plan together and always focus on the positive traits your child possesses.

Thank you for meeting with your child's teacher next week. Come with an open mind and heart, prepared to listen and really hear and appreciate the perspective from a professional that wants only the best year for your child.

Parking on School Grounds (Playground and Basketball Areas)

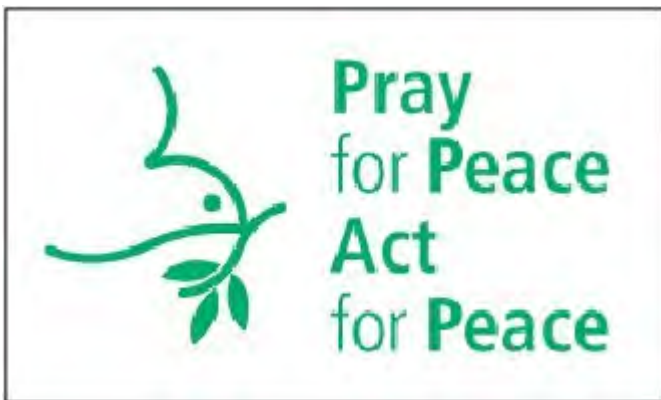

SAS Alum News

We are proud to report news about our SAS alumni and what they are currently up to; Today we will be profiling Matt Mazzoni who graduated from St. Anthony's in 2004. Matt has three other siblings who attended SAS as well, his older brother Mike Mazzoni, Class of 2000, his sister Julia, Class of 2002, and his younger brother Carlo, Class of 2009. Matt attended San Joaquin Memorial where he played baseball and basketball and graduated in 2008. He attended Fresno Pacific University as a student-athlete. He enjoyed a stellar four-year career as a pitcher on the Sunbird baseball team. He graduated as the program's all-time

leader in career strikeouts, finished a second all-time in wins and finished in the top five in ERA and opponents' batting averages. The Sunbirds reached the national postseason in three of his four years. He graduated from FPU in 2012 with a degree in communications. He spent a year as the FPU athletics communications assistant during the 2012-2013 season. He assisted with all aspects of the FPU sports information operations, including holding a lead role in social media strategy and content creation. He then went to UC San Diego where he served as the athletics communications assistant and oversaw coverage of the softball, cross country and men's & women's water polo programs, while serving as the secondary contact for numerous sports. In August of 2014, Matt rejoined the FPU staff as the Assistant Director of Athletics Communication and in 2016 he was named the Director of Athletic Communications. - * Squares are crossed out when you purchase Carnival food, play games or enjoy rides
- * No other form of payment is accepted at any food, beverage, game, or ride booth
- * Each scrip sheet has 20 squares
- * Carnival scrip is \$12.00 per sheet if you **pre-order and pay by 3:00p Friday, Sept. 23rd**
- * Carnival Scrip will cost \$15.00 per sheet at the Carnival.
- * Submit orders to the school office by Friday September 23rd
- * Place completed form and payment (cash, check, VISA or MasterCard) in an envelope marked "CARNIVAL SCRIP ORDER". Payment is due with your order – NO exceptions.
- * Pick up Scrip at the Pre-Order Scrip Booth on Carnival Day.

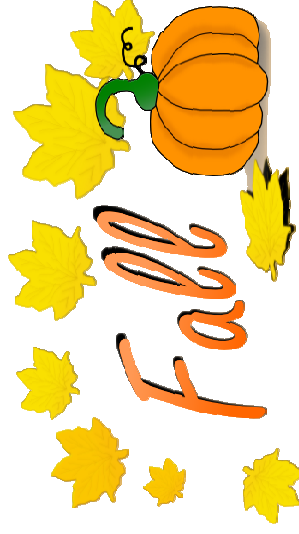
